Any competitor, exhibitor, owner found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary Regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee and dealt with accordingly.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Entry fees are stated in each Section
- 2 Championship ribbons will be awarded on the day of the event (except when otherwise directed by the stewards).
Entries must not be removed until after 4.30pm on the day of the Show.
- 3 Prize money is to be collected on the day. Any prize money not collected by October 30, shall be declared forfeited.
- 4 All trophies to remain the property of the Society until won outright.
- 5 The Committee will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits or for any injury to any competitor taking part in any event.
- 6 The Judge's decision shall be final. Any protest must be lodged with the Secretary, in writing, accompanied by a \$25 deposit (which will be forfeited if protest is deemed frivolous) before 3.30pm on Show day to be dealt with by the Committee.
- 7 When the Judge considers an exhibit in any class does not possess sufficient merit to deserve a prize, the said money may be withheld.
- 8 Applications for ground space for Side Shows must be made to the Secretary not less than seven days prior to the Show, and must be accompanied by the necessary fee. Proprietors must confine themselves strictly to such space as is allotted to them by the Society.
- 9 The contents of this schedule have been carefully compiled and are believed to be correct, but the Committee will not hold itself responsible for any errors or omissions.
- 10 An only entry in class may receive a prize at the Judge's discretion.
- 11 All entry fees must be paid prior to judging.
- 12 Committee reserves the right to reject or refuse any entry and shall not be required to give a reason for doing so.
